A Glimpse at Borana Culture—The Gorfa

God continues to weave the Gospel For All family tightly together in ways that only He could orchestrate. Year by year supporters have joined with us and shared the vision for reaching the lost for Christ. In the future, as God weaves additional strands into our ministry, we hope to be able to expand in to other areas and hire additional evangelists from different backgrounds.

Until God leads us in another direction, we are committed to the area where we are currently working — among the Borana Oromo.

The Borana Oromo live mainly in southern Ethiopia and northern Kenya. There are more than half a million Borana Oromo living throughout southern Ethiopia. The Borana are a tribe of nomadic pastoralists with a unique culture. Before the introduction of Islam and Christianity, the Borana prac-

ticed their own religion. They believe in one Waaqayoo (or God). Many Borana continue to practice their traditional religious beliefs alongside Islam or Christianity once they convert.

Along with their own religion, there are also many items unique to the Borana Oromo. One of these is the gorfa. A gorfa is one of the many basket like containers made and used by the Borana. The fibers used in making these containers are woven very tightly. The end product is light to carry and extremely durable. It is an ideal container for liquids. A key characteristic of the gorfa is the application of cowries. Cowries are small white shells used to decorate the container. They use these on many of their woven items.

All Borana women are expected to learn how to make woven milk containers, such as the *gorfa*. Milk containers are vital objects in the Borana culture where raising cattle is their livelihood. Milk is a symbol of abundance. Fertility is associated with the weaving. The container and the milk together symbolize the ideal combination of abundance and fertility which are the two fundamental requirements for the reproduction and prosperity of the community.

In the Borana society, women make woven containers and men carve wood containers. Even though both types of containers can serve the same basic function, they are used in different social settings. Some containers have both wood and basketry components and therefore require the work of both a man and





a woman, usually a husband and wife or at least members of the family living in the same household. These containers reflect a key element of Borana culture, a healthy interdependence between man and woman manifest in the complementary roles men and women perform in their families and communities.

I have a *gorfa* in my home. It was given to me on my first trip to Ethiopia and is one of my most cherished mementos. To me it has always been a beautiful piece of craftsmanship. Just recently, I learned the significance of the *gorfa* and now that I understand the importance of this item in everyday Borana life, I look at it in an entirely different light.

Just as the fibers of the *gorfa* are tightly woven together to form a sturdy, durable container, my prayer is that Gospel For All will be able to reach out to the Borana people and have the love of Christ woven tightly into their lives and communities.

The evangelists left Mega to return to their places of service with a better understanding of the reality of the spiritual warfare they are facing.
